The Anti-Ragging Committee of Astha Mahavidyalaya ensures a safe, respectful, and ragging-free campus environment. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Any student found involved will face strict action as per UGC Regulations 2009 and applicable laws.

Aims and Objectives

1. To implement and enforce anti-ragging regulations as prescribed by statutory and regulatory authorities.
2. To adopt preventive measures and maintain vigilance to eliminate ragging from the campus.
3. To create awareness among students (freshers and seniors), faculty, and staff regarding anti-ragging rules and responsibilities.
4. To ensure that all actions are in accordance with the guidelines issued by UGC and other competent authorities.
5. To maintain proper records and periodically report anti-ragging activities to institutional authorities.
6. To take strict disciplinary action against students involved in ragging, including:
 - Suspension from attending classes
 - Cancellation of scholarships, fellowships, or other benefits
 - Debarment from examinations
 - Any other disciplinary action deemed appropriate by the institution

Astha Mahavidyalaya is committed to providing a safe, inclusive, and ragging-free environment. Students are encouraged to report any incidents of ragging without fear, as all complaints are handled with strict confidentiality and prompt action.
